



- To examine the minutes and Action Taken Reports of the Grievance Redressal Committee, Internal Complaint Committee, Anti-Sexual Harassment Committee, and Women Empowerment Cell and ensure that resolutions are made as soon as possible.
- To promote female student participation in NCC and NSS and to provide their equal rights and participation in regular cultural events. Addressing problems like depression and frustration can be brought on by failures through professional counseling sessions.
