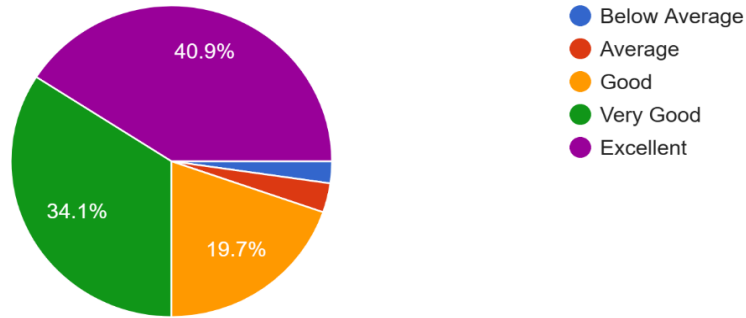

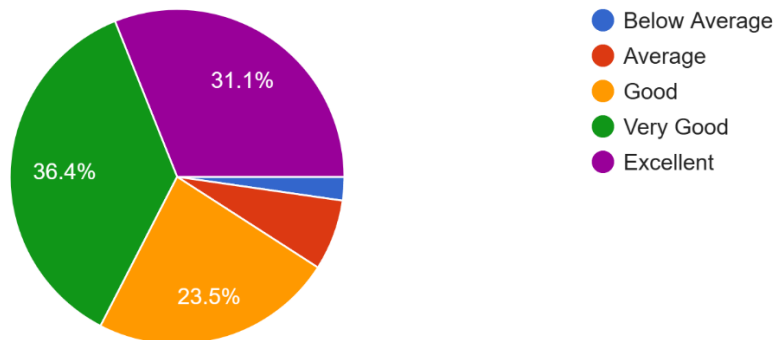
Have you learned any administrative skills, soft skills, and moral values during your tenure in the college?

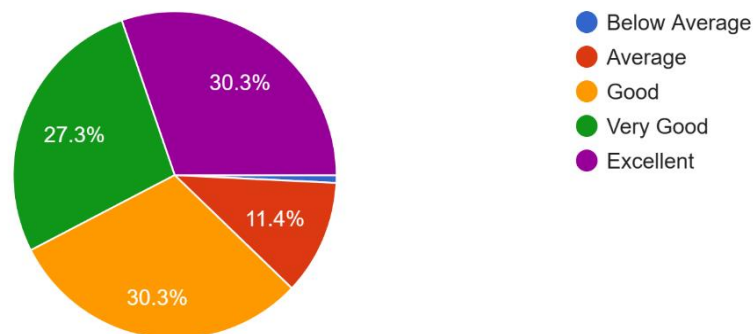
To what extent the course during your time fulfil the skill development of the students as per industrial norms?

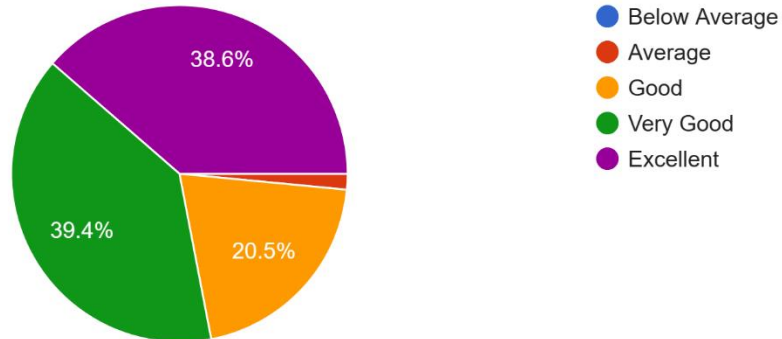

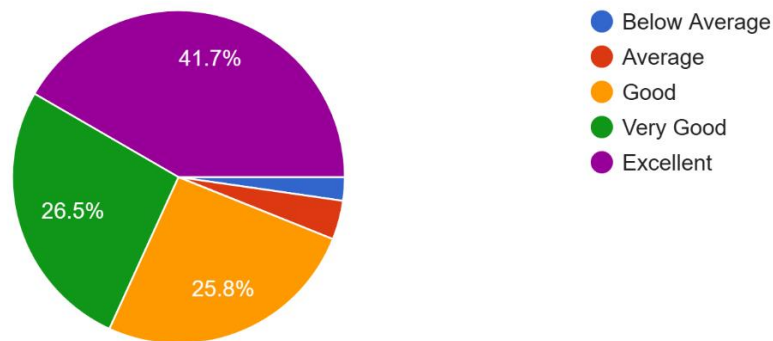
How will you rate the outcome that you achieved when you passed out from the college?

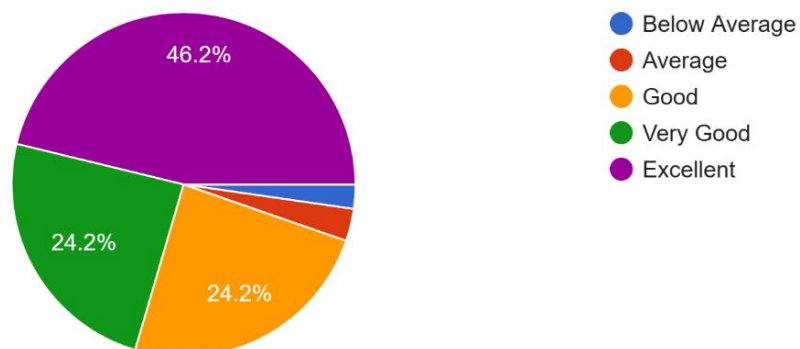
To what extent you are satisfied with ACP's policy for student welfare?

How are you satisfied with the facilities provided in institution during your time?

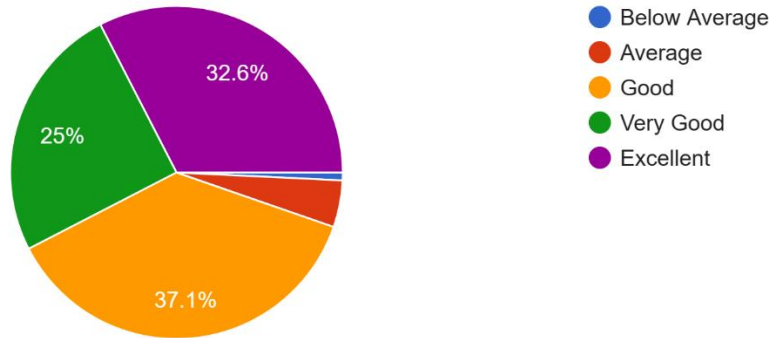

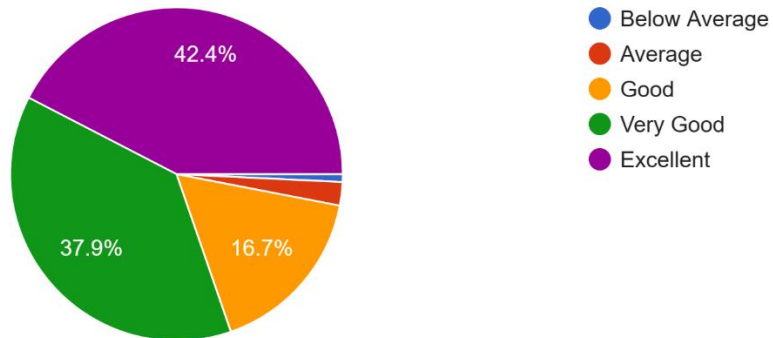
To what extent you feel any addition should be made to the curriculum of your time?

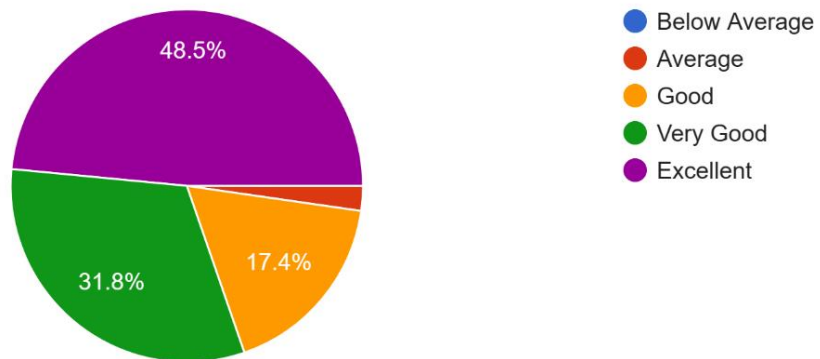
To what extent you feel that more skill based activities should be involved in the curriculum?

Analysis Report:

Analysis of feedback from alumni mentioned that nearly 96.2% of the alumni have found the current curriculum is suitable for the course to great extent. Nearly 75% of the alumni feel that they have learnt good administrative skills, soft skills, and moral values during their tenure in the college. 57.6 % of the alumni found the syllabus helpful in facing professional challenges. About 52.6% alumni feel that curriculum provided by the university was not up to the mark during their tenure in the college. Amongst all, 57.6% alumni feel strongly that more frequent revision of syllabus and curriculum is needed. Most of the alumni, i.e. 80.30% believes that there is a great need of addition of the skill-based courses in the curriculum. 98.7% alumni have given good to excellent rating to the college.

Analysis Report:

When the student feedback on curriculum are compiled it is found that nearly 75.8% of the students feel that the curriculum is suitable to the course and need based. Nearly 74.4% of the students found satisfactory balance of the course curriculum between theory and application. 76.4% of the students found that the syllabus is capable to develop skills in the students as per industrial requirements and norms. Approximately 76.4% students agreed that the course enables the students to face professional challenges. Approximately 54% of the students think that the course is need to be updated or revised more frequently. Nearly 76.8% believe that there is strong need of addtion of skill based courses in the curriculum.

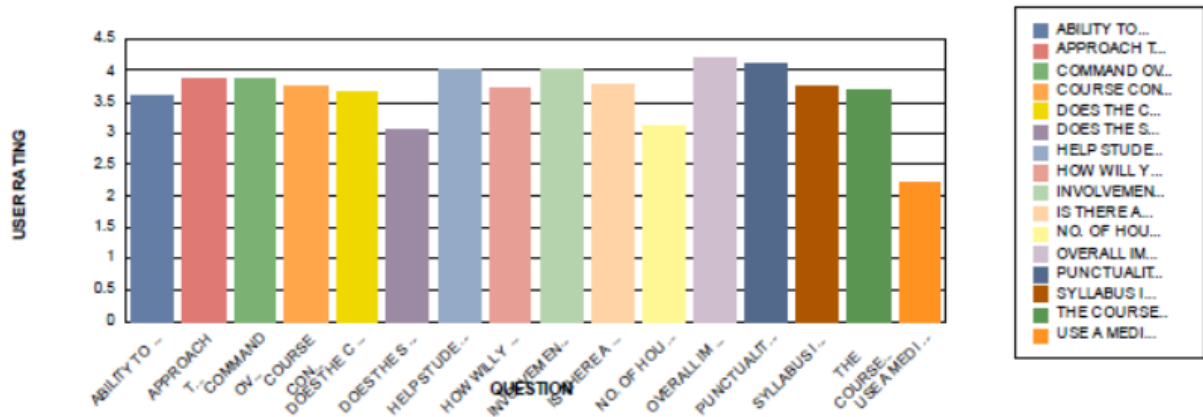

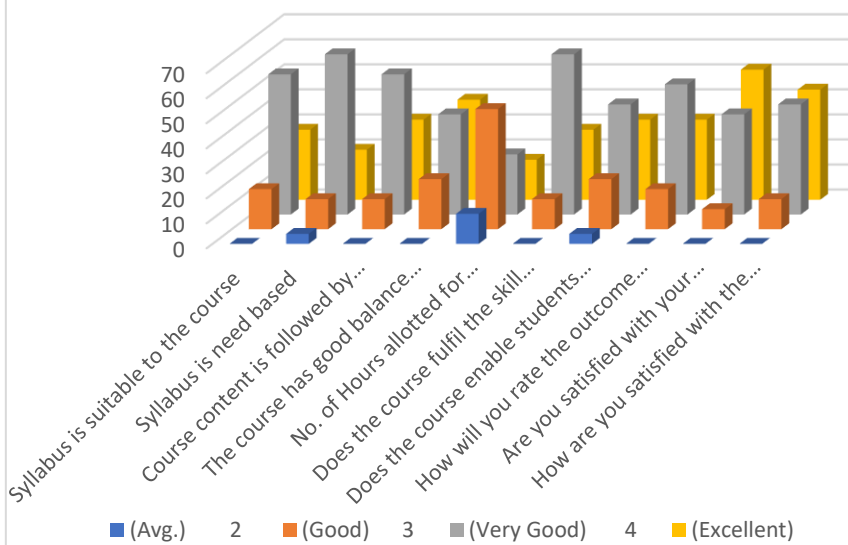
Analysis Report:

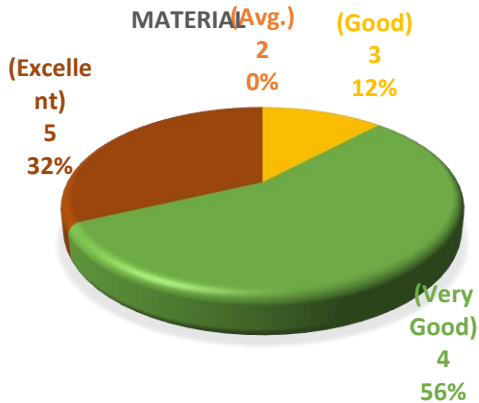

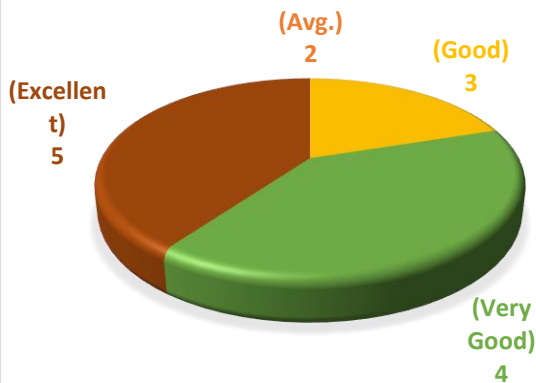

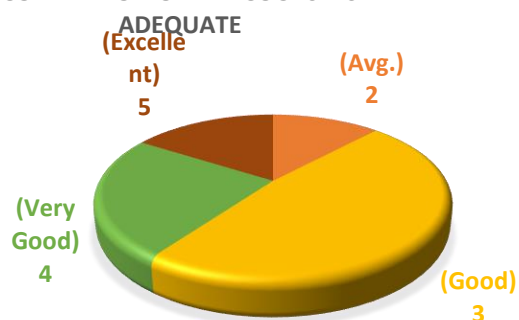


THE COURSE HAS GOOD BALANCE BETWEEN THEORY AND APPLICATIONS

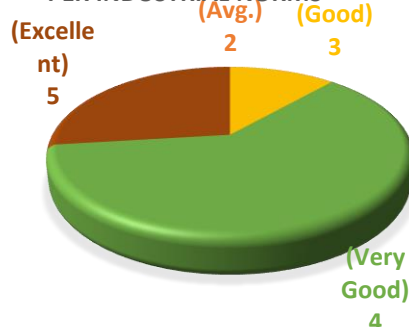

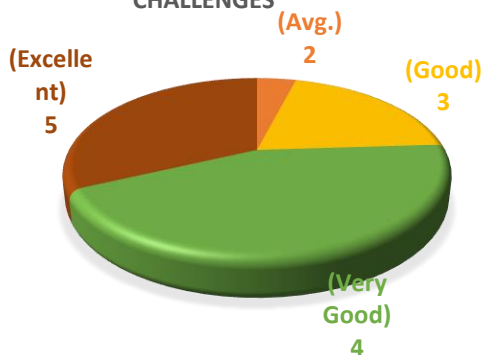
NO. OF HOURS ALLOTTED FOR COMPLETION OF THE COURSE IS



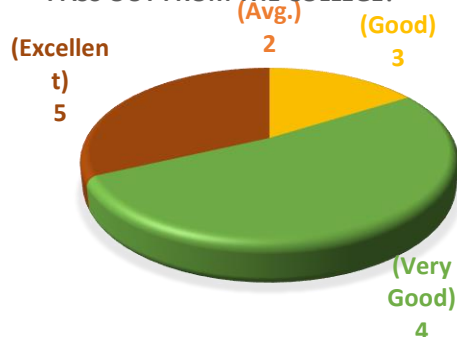
DOES THE COURSE FULFIL THE SKILL DEVELOPMENT OF THE STUDENTS AS PER INDUSTRIAL NORMS



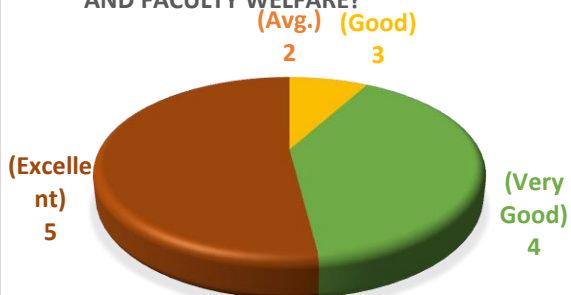
DOES THE COURSE ENABLE STUDENTS IN FACING PROFESSIONAL CHALLENGES



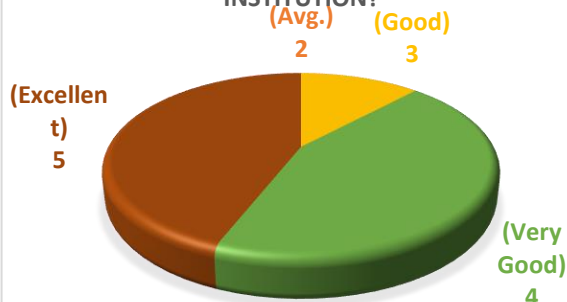

Analysis Report:

Teachers feedback on curriculum are collected from the faculty members. The feedbacks are analysed and it was found that, most of the teachers have given very good remark with 4 rating on many of the questions in questionnaire as shown in pie charts above. Nearly 60 percent of the faculty feels that the number of hours allotted are not satisfactory for given syllabus in curriculum. 80% of the teachers agree with the fact that the course has good balance between theory and applications. Nearly 92% of the faculties are fairly agreed that the course fulfil the skill development of the students as per industrial

norms. 84% of the teachers feel that student will get very good learning outcome when they will pass out from the college with this curriculum. About 92% of the faculty members are satisfied with the student and faculty welfare policies of the institute and 8% of them need improvement in this regard.

Feedback Analysis Report of Employers Feedback on Curriculum

Analysis Report:

We have collected feedback from the employers of the alumni of the institute. Almost all the employers are satisfied with the professional qualities of their employees from this college. They are pleased with their employees in relation to facing challenges and helping others.
